ANNAMALAI UNIVERSITY

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Annamalai University, one of the largest residential universities in Southern Asia, was established and incorporated in the year 1929 as per the Annamalai University Act, 1928 (Tamil Nadu Act 1 of 1929). The Annamalai University Act, 1928 was repealed and replaced by the Annamalai University Act, 2013 (Tamil Nadu Act 20 of 2013). The Hon'ble Governor of Tamil Nadu is the Chancellor of the University.

This University has, since its inception, been aiming at imparting education in all fields of knowledge to thousands of students from across the country and abroad. Located in a rural setting in the coastal district of Cuddalore in Tamil Nadu, the University has played a pivotal role in providing access to higher education to lakhs of youth from economically and socially disadvantaged classes. In this respect, this University's service to the nation is remarkable.

In the past 95 years, the University has grown into a premier institution of higher learning and research. The University today is spread over an extensive campus of more than 800 acres and has the Faculties of Arts, Science, Marine Sciences, Indian Languages, Engineering and Technology, Education, Fine Arts, Agriculture, Medicine, and Dentistry in all, and comprising 55 Departments of Study.

Annamalainagar is a busy and self-contained University township, east of Chidambaram town, the abode of Lord Nataraja, the Cosmic Dancer. The sprawling and scenic campus enclosing the Departments of Study, Students' Hostels, Staff Quarters, Playgrounds, etc., is situated at a holy place (Tiruvetkalam, currently known as Annamalainagar), 2 kms from the Lord Nataraja Temple.

The University was brought under the ambit of the Govt. of Tamil Nadu by the enactment of Annamalai University Act 2013 (Tamil Nadu Act 20 of 2013). The Act of 2013 has been amended by enactment of Act No.32 of 2021 to render the university as an affiliating type. Consequently, the colleges situated in the districts of Cuddalore, Villupuam, Kallakurichi and Mayiladuthurai have been affiliated to Annamalai University.

The Sir C.P. Ramaswamy Aiyar Library of the University is the third biggest in Tamil Nadu and has a collection of more than 5 lakh volumes besides journals, reports and rare palm-leaf manuscripts. It has all the modern facilities such as Internet, Microfilming, Infilbnet, RFID etc.

The University plays a vital role in disseminating knowledge acquired through research to the surrounding rural areas in which it is placed and it serves the larger community through its Centre for Rural Development, the Department of Community Medicine, Dental College, the NSS; and above all, through its Centre for Distance and Online Education, it takes education to the doorsteps of thousands of adult learners.

The Centre for Distance and Online Education, established in 1979, offers different programmes of study. It is well equipped with computer and other infrastructure, adequate teaching faculty and administrative set-up of Learner Support Centres, computer training centres, etc., to serve its students. It has also the unique distinction of being the first to offer Postgraduate Degree Programmes in Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany, and Computer Science through Open and Distance Learning mode.

2. Year 2025-2026 (January Session)

The year 2025-2026 (January Session) of the Centre for Distance and Online Education is from 1st January to 31st December.

3. APPLICATION FORM

The Application form with Prospectus can be obtained in person and online. The cost of Application is as follows:

The Students can also download the application form through online from our websites: www.audde.in / www.annamalaiuniversity.ac.in by paying the prescribed cost.

The Application form is not transferable and the application for admission should be in the prescribed form for the Year 2025–26 (January Session) issued by the CDOE or any of its Learner Support Centres.

4.(A) INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING IN THE APPLICATION FORM

- (i) Read the Application form and the Prospectus carefully and thoroughly before you begin to fill.
- (ii) Check your eligibility, i.e., minimum required educational qualification, for the programme you are applying for.
- (iii) While filling in the application form, enter the programme code, name of the programme, medium of instruction and optional subjects clearly and correctly.
- (iv) A recent Passport size photograph should be uploaded on the Application form.
- (v) Upload self attested copies of certificates for the educational qualification, 10th Marksheet, 11th and 12th Marksheet, U.G. Degree/ Provisional Certificate(s), Transfer Certificate/ Migration Certificate and Community Certificate.
- (vi) If the certificates submitted by the applicant are in a language other than English/ Tamil, an attested English version of the certificates should accompany them.
- (vii) Application will be summarily rejected if there is any discrepancy between the material particulars filled in the application form and the supporting documents. The name of the applicant, his/her date of birth and qualification will be considered as material particulars in this context.
- (viii) Those who have passed the qualifying examination under 10+2+2 pattern will be considered for admission to Diploma programmes only.
- (ix) Candidates having a direct U.G. Degree (without +2 Qualification) / Candidates having a direct P.G. Degree (without U.G. degree) / any degree in U.G. passed through OUS are not eligible.

(x) Applicants possessing degrees awarded by Universities/Colleges/ Institutes which are not recognized by the University Grants Commission are not eligible for admission to the programmes offered by the Centre for Distance and Online Education.

(xi) However, the student pursuing a degree programme is permitted to join or study a Certificate /Grade Certificate / Diploma programme concurrently.

(xii) But, the University will not be in a position to make adjustments, if there is any clash in the examination schedule between the two programmes taken.

The Students have to complete the programme (Dip. / Cert. /Grade Cert.) (Theory and Practical / Project) / within 4 years [Time span = N + 3] from the year of admission, failing which, their registration will stand automatically cancelled and they have to register afresh if they want to continue the programme. But the students should have paid the programme fee for all the years of study before last date specified.

4.(B) CONFIRMATION OF ADMISSION

5. FEE CONCESSION

(i) Differently Abled students including those Visually Challenged residing in Tamil Nadu are exempted from payment of Tuition Fees, Special Fees and Alumni Fees on production of a Disability Certificate issued by the District Welfare Officer for the Differently Abled Citizens. However, they are required to pay the other prescribed fees such as admission fee, registration fee, eligibility fee, postage, PCP fee etc.

(ii) 50% Flat Fee concession is available to

1. Students pursuing Post Graduate (P.G.) Programme in Regular / Distance Mode, in Arts & Science or Professional (Engineering, Medical and Agriculture) Colleges, are permitted to enrol concurrently to any one of the Diploma or Certificate programmes according to eligibility through CDOE

mode. However, fee concession is not applicable for DCA Programme.

2. The current Under Graduate (U.G.) students of regular / Distance mode or Polytechnic students can enrol in any one of the eligible Diploma / Certificate programmes.
3. M.Phil or Ph.D. Scholars of any recognised University can enrol in any one of the eligible Diploma or Certificate Programmes.

Note: These fee concessions are not applicable for enrolment in Computer Science and IT Programmes.

6. PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

(A) Admission

Applicants living near to any of the Learner Support Centres can gather information about admission from it. Selection for direct admission to all the programmes will be made at the Centre.

For Admission, the candidates must submit filled in application along with the following documents in person:

Original Certificates will be returned immediately after verification. The Transfer Certificate/Migration Certificate will also be returned after affixing a seal that the candidate is admitted for the year 2025-26 (January Session).

Registration is subject to the Confirmation or Cancellation (if found not eligible) by the Director, CDOE.

(B) Admission through Post

If the applicant's place is not near to any of the Learner Support Centres, the filled-in application pasted with a passport size photograph may be sent to The Director, Centre for Distance and Online Education, Annamalai University, Annamalai Nagar – 608 002 along with self attested Photostat copies of the documents listed in the Table shown above.

On receipt of provisional admission card, the applicant has to send by Registered post or Courier or Speed post or produce in person, the Original Certificates of photostat documents submitted along with application for ((i) Educational qualification (ii) Transfer/ Migration Certificate (self attested photostat copies enclosed with the application form) and receipt of payment for the prescribed fees), observing the guidelines classified in the Mode of Payment in item no. 8.

After the confirmation of admission, the signed identity card and the original certificates including Transfer Certificate/Migration Certificate after affixing a seal on the TC that the candidate is admitted during the year 2025-26 (January Session), will be returned to the student through Registered post.

If the certificates submitted by a candidate are found to be bogus (or) fake, his/her admission will be cancelled and the fees remitted will also be forfeited.

Tuition Fees may be paid through the following modes:

Internet (Online) Banking Payments:

Students or their parents having Internet Banking facilities or Debit / Credit Card can make the payment of fees online by accessing the CDOE website www.audde.in and clicking the Link "Online Payment". Account holders of the designated Banks providing the service will not be

charged any service fee for payment transfers from their internet banking accounts. Payments may also be made through the Internet using Visa / Master Credit / Debit cards, as service charges claimed by Banks do vary, and users should check them also.

Demand Drafts / Cheques / Postal Orders / Money Orders etc. are not acceptable modes of payments.

Fees relating to relating to Examinations may be paid through the above modes.

8. ENROLMENT NUMBER

The students admitted will be assigned an Enrolment Number. The first three digits of the enrolment number represent the programme code, the 4th and 5th digits represent the year of admission, namely 25 for 2025-26 (January Session) and the rest of the digits represent the serial number of admission for that programme. This number, which is different from the Application Number, will continue to be the same till a student completes the programme.

Students should invariably quote their Enrolment numbers in all correspondences with the CDOE. Letters / Mails received without the Enrolment Number will not receive any attention.

9. IDENTITY CARD

Students will be issued a signed Identity Card by the CDOE after their admission. Students should keep their Identity Card safely till the completion of the Programme and must bring their Identity Card at the time of Personal Contact Programmes (PCP) and Examinations.

Students who have lost their Identity Card, can obtain a **Duplicate Identity Card from the CDOE** on requisition along with passport size photo and prescribed fee of ₹200/- to **The Director, Centre for Distance and Online Education, Annamalai University** through any one of the classified modes of payment as mentioned in page no. 8.

10. DESPATCH OF SELF LEARNING STUDY MATERIALS

The Regulations and Syllabus for the Programme will be supplied along with the study materials. **The soft copy can be downloaded from the website.**

The syllabus and Self Learning Study Materials for all the programmes will be supplied during the time of Admission.

For the Second, Third and Fourth semesters/years, the Self Learning Study Materials will be despatched by the CDOE through Post on receipt of the Tuition Fee for the respective years and also the students should have paid the fees in full for the previous years.

Students who have lost their Self Learning Study Materials can obtain another set of Self Learning Study Materials from the CDOE on requisition along with prescribed fee of ₹200/- per subject for all Programmes through any one of the classified modes of payment as mentioned in page no. 8.

11. PERSONAL CONTACT PROGRAMME (PCP)

Personal Contact Programmes, hereafter referred to as PCP, will be arranged in Annamalai Nagar, for all the programmes offered by the CDOE. Students should make their own arrangements for their board and lodging at the centres where PCPs are held. There are no separate PCPs for differently abled students.

A circular with details of date, venue and time for the PCP for the whole year will be downloaded from the **website: www.audde.in** The CDOE reserves the right to fix, shift or cancel any PCP.

Generally, the PCPs are held on Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays during which, lectures and discussions will be held on all subjects including orientation to do the practicals. Students are advised to avail this facility. If they bring the recommended text books along with Self learning Study Materials received from the CDOE, they will find the PCPs immensely useful.

PCP Attendance is optional for most of the Programmes, unless otherwise specified.

12(a) COMPULSORY PERSONAL CONTACT PROGRAMMES (CPCP)

Attendance at Personal Contact Programmes (PCP) is compulsory for certain specified programmes to the extent of 100% as per the regulations governing them. Centres where these Programmes are to be held will be intimated to the students well in advance, in order to enable them to make necessary board and lodging arrangements for attending the programmes.

Attendance Certificate will be issued to the students on the last day of the PCPs.

12(b). REGULATIONS GOVERNING ATTENDANCE AT PCPs

- a. Students attending the compulsory PCPs should sign in the Attendance Register on all days maintained for the purpose. No student will be eligible to appear for the Examinations, if he/she fails to satisfy the minimum requirement of attendance at the compulsory PCPs.
- b. Even if a candidate appears for the examinations without attending the compulsory PCPs, the results of the examination will not be declared.
- c. Computer Programmes: The compulsory PCPs will be conducted in different spells for the computer subjects of the programmes. Attendance at these PCPs to the extent of 100% is compulsory.
- d. Students who fail to attend the compulsory PCP in a particular year, will be permitted to attend the same in the subsequent years on requisition, along with a fee of ₹1000/- in the immediate subsequent semester and ₹500/- for each additional semester thereafter.
- e. Students who have lost the Attendance Certificate issued to them on the last day of the compulsory PCP, may get a Duplicate Attendance Certificate from the CDOE on requisition along with a payment of ₹ 300/- through anyone of the classified modes of payment as mentioned in page no.8.

13. RESPONSE SHEETS/ASSIGNMENTS

Response Sheet Questions / Assignment topics can be downloaded from our University website www.audde.in, wherever it is compulsory. Students are advised to submit it

within the prescribed date. **Submission of Response Sheets / Assignments is compulsory** for C.L.I.S. Students will have to use their own stationery to write the answers.

Students who submit assignments after the last date should pay a fine of ₹300/- as through any one of the classified modes of payment mentioned in page no. 8.

14. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

Communications will be sent to the address given by the students in the Application form. If there is any change of address (will not be permitted after announcement of final year examinations), it should be intimated to the CDOE immediately with a prescribed fee of ₹300/- through any one of the classified modes of payment as mentioned in page no. 8. Students are advised to inform the Post Office concerned to redirect the study materials and all other communications to their new address until the change is effected.

15. CHANGE OF NAME

Those who wish to have their names changed in the records of the CDOE at the time of admission or during the period of study (correction of change of name, photo and date of birth will not be permitted after completion of the programme), must apply for the same along with the Original Gazette notification. If the Gazette Notification is in a language other than English or Tamil, a certified translation must accompany the request. Such change of name will have only prospective effect. Attested or Photostat copy of Gazette Notification is not accepted.

The requisition for change of name may be applied to the CDOE along with prescribed fee of ₹500/- through any one of the classified modes of payment as mentioned in page no. 8.

16. CHANGE OF PROGRAMME /MEDIUM / OPTIONAL SUBJECT

Students who desire to change the programme or medium of instruction or optional subject (if they fulfil the eligibility conditions) chosen at the time of applying for admission, may apply to the CDOE along with

the prescribed fee of ₹750/- through any one of the classified modes of payment mentioned in page no. 8. However these changes will be considered only during the admission period of the year.

Late applications for such changes will not be considered.

17. TRANSFER / MIGRATION CERTIFICATE

This University's Transfer Certificate will be issued by the Centre for Distance and Online Education only to students who have completed/discontinued their programme of study and who do not have any arrears of fee. INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES
(Regarding Examinations)

1. Candidates can only register for examination through Online in the University Website <http://coe.annamalaiuniversity.ac.in/bank/ddeapp.php> and only online payment should be done. Candidates having Tuition fee due cannot register for examinations.
2. The actual date of online registration will be the criterion for arriving at the rate of late fee. The answer papers of candidates who appear for the examinations without registering for the same will not be valued under any circumstance.
3. Candidates should register for the examination only after remitting the tuition fees due to the Centre for Distance and Online Education.
4. At the first appearance, candidates should register for all the subjects of the respective Year/Semester, and pay the fees for all the subjects, whether they intend to appear for all the subjects or not. The fee once paid, will not be refunded or adjusted or carried over to a subsequent examination.
5. Those who have not attended the compulsory PCP (Personal Contact Programme) should not appear for the examination, and even if they appear, their results will be withheld.
6. Candidates must enter their Enrolment Number, Full Name (in CAPITAL LETTER) and other particulars correctly while applying online.
7. An examination centre once selected, should not be changed under any circumstances. A candidate should write all the examinations only in one centre. If a candidate appears in an examination centre to which he/she is not allotted, his/her answer scripts will not be valued (strictly). The candidates are responsible for their entry error in writing the centre code of examination centre. Hence, the candidates are instructed to register their centre code carefully. The date and venue of Practical and Viva Voce examinations will be announced separately. The centre/ venue of the practical/viva-voce examination will be fixed based on the number of candidates registering. Candidates cannot claim the same city/centre/venue where they appeared for theory examinations. Practical examinations for certain programmes will be held at Annamalai Nagar only.

8. Information regarding Examination Centres allotted to all registered candidates including their Register Numbers, subject registered etc. will be available on the University Website (www.annamalaiuniversity.ac.in) well in advance before the commencement of the Examinations. The Candidates should download their Hall-tickets from the University Website only and produce the same at the time of examination, along with their Identity Card issued by the DDE, Annamalai University.
9. Candidates will be provided only one blank answer booklet containing 40 pages with OMR (Optical Mark Recognition) Sheet as cover page. No additional sheets will be provided. Candidates should write their correct Register Number in their Answer script and shade the numbers properly. If it is found later that a wrong or incomplete number has been written or wrong/incomplete shading, the result will not be published and after verification, a penalty of Rs. 750/- per subject will be imposed on the candidates.
10. After publication of the results (in the University Website), the Statement of Marks and Provisional/Pass Certificate (if eligible) will be sent to the candidates through Registered Post. The University will not be responsible for the mark sheet/certificate lost in transit.
11. Regarding any discrepancy in attendance (or) marks, written request letters from candidates should be received within 15 days from the date of publication of results in the University Website. Revaluation of only Theory paper is permitted, if an application along with a fee of Rs. 2,000/- per Subject is received within 15 days from the date of publication of results on the University Website. Late requests will not be considered under any circumstances.
12. Dissertation/Project Report should be submitted within the deadline. Late submissions will not be considered for evaluation.
